

10. Letter from Dr. A. Führer in Camp Sagrawah to W. C. Peppé in Birdpore, dated 23 February 1898.

He is finishing his work and goes tomorrow to Lori Kudan to examine 'another broken pillar'. Hopes to arrive at Piprawakot on Friday evening. Regrets it is impossible to do any excavation work as he has to proceed elsewhere but his draftsman will prepare drawings and take photos, if permitted.

Camp Sagrawah, the 23rd Feb. 1898

Dear Mr. Peppé,

Please accept my sincerest thanks for so kindly sending me my wife's letter and a paper [?]. We have only just [] [] [] our work, and I am going tomorrow to Lori Kudan near Taulihon [?], where there had [] another broken pillar. I hope to arrive at Piprawakot on Friday evening at about six o'clock, and shall be glad to see you on Saturday morning, in order to see what is to be done next season, as I fear it will be almost impossible for me to commence the work this season, as I have to go to Khajnapore [] in Bundelkhand on some urgent work. Of course, my draftsman will prepare drawings of the places [] [] by you and also to do photos [?] of all the relic caskets, and their contents, if you will so kindly permit it.
